# MS Society 'Guess My Time' Sweepstake

## How this game works:

- 1 Stick the poster up somewhere easily visible at your workplace or residence.
- 2 Decide on a suggested donation amount (e.g. £2) and write this in the space provided at the top of the poster.
- 3 Decide on a prize (either a percentage of money raised from the game, or a non-monetary prize of your choice), and advertise this in the space provided at the top of the poster.
- 4 Ask your friends or colleagues to guess your finish time in return for the suggested donation. Write their name and contact details along with a record of their guess in the space provided.
- 5 After your challenge, present the winner with their prize and donate the money raised to MS Society UK.

  - Or, if you have collected cash, please pay this into your own account, and then either make a payment to your online fundraising page, or send a cheque to: MS Society, Edgware Road, London, NW2 6ND. Please make your cheque payable to 'MS Society' and enclose a note of your name and address.
- 6 Please read the terms and conditions below before playing.

## Terms and conditions

- 1 This sweepstake is an exempt lottery under the Gambling Act 2005 and is promoted by the organiser.
- 2 The winner will be the person whose time is closest to the runner's finishing time. If the finishing time is exactly between two guesses, the person with the lower guess will win the prize. Prizes may not be rolled over.
- 3 The sweepstake is for use in the UK only.
- 4 No two people can guess the same time.
- 5 This sweepstake must be conducted as a work or residents lottery. This means that people are only eligible to enter if they either work or live in the same premises as the promoter.
- 6 You may only display this poster or advertise the sweepstake on the premises in which the sweepstake is taking place.
- 7 The entry price must be the same for all participants.
- 8 All participants should be aged 16 or over.
- 9 The game will close on a date of the promoter's choosing, to be announced in advance, and where possible the winner will be revealed within 5 working days of the closing date.
- 10 The promoter is responsible for ensuring the sweepstake is run properly – MS Society UK is not a promoter and does not accept any responsibility for your sweepstake.
- 11 Any personal information collected will only be used for the proper purposes of this promotion.
- 12 All monies raised will be donated to MS Society UK.
